HOMEAID ATLANTA ASSISTS VETERANS AND TEENS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

Building industry volunteers transform metro Atlanta homes for people in need

ATLANTA, GA – September 10, 2020 – HomeAid Care Days provide maintenance, upgrades, and repairs for nonprofits that serve people experiencing homelessness in metro Atlanta.

On August 21, volunteers from **Meritage Homes, McMichael and Gray, PC, and Keller Williams Realty Atlanta** spent the day at a HomeAid Care Day at **Jesus Set the Captive Free (JSCF)**, a southwest Atlanta home for veterans experiencing homelessness. The group worked outside despite rain and mud to complete landscaping tasks including installing a garden bed with shrubs, cutting back extensive brush around the property, and removing a fallen tree. Inside the house, volunteers painted walls in need of a touch up, as well as installed drywall in a food pantry area. The work of volunteers made a major impact on the home, which will house six veterans working to rebuild their lives. Volunteer Rhea Dawkins with McMichael and Gray said, “Thank you, HomeAid, for all that you do and the opportunity to be a part of wonderful, life-changing opportunities like this one.”

On August 26, volunteers from **Taylor Morrison Atlanta** participated in a HomeAid Care Day in Canton at **North Georgia Angel House**, a home for teenaged girls in the foster care system. The group completed a variety of projects, including painting, repairing a deck, renovating a bathroom, installing a new door, pressure washing, installing new lighting and ceiling fans, creating a water divergent plan, and digging a new trench. In November 2019, Taylor

Morrison completed a major renovation at North Georgia Angel House including a total kitchen renovation, drywall and flooring repairs related to water intrusion issues, and more. “Taylor Morrison Atlanta loves our community and making a difference anytime we can is what we do,” said Taylor Morrison Area Construction Manager Ronnie Cline, who coordinated this Care Day.

HomeAid Atlanta is a nonprofit organization founded in 2001 that builds new lives for families and individuals experiencing homelessness through housing and community outreach. HomeAid builds, renovates, and maintains facilities for nonprofits that serve people experiencing homelessness. HomeAid has completed over 140 projects at locations for victims of domestic violence, teen mothers, veterans and more, utilizing connections with building industry professionals and community organizations.
