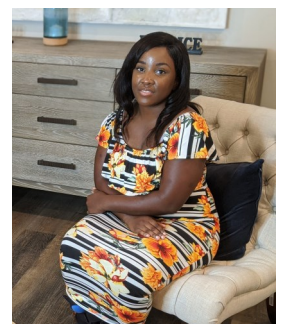

In 2020, HomeAid Atlanta built the Second Chance Home at House of Dawn with HomeAid Builder Captain Knight Homes. Our work at House of

Dawn allows the organization to focus more on helping young mothers at risk for homelessness, and worry less about facility construction and maintenance. Savings allow more and better assistance to help people like Salaam, who came to House of Dawn after leaving an abusive home, six months pregnant with her daughter. "I didn't know what it felt like to have a family. House of Dawn showed me love and they never gave up on me. I wasn't used to that." Now Salaam is in college and hopes to become a forensic analyst.

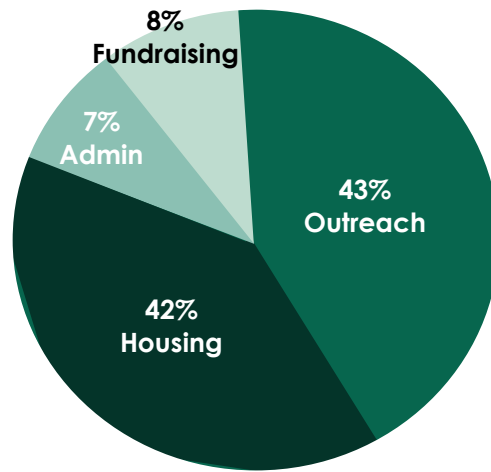

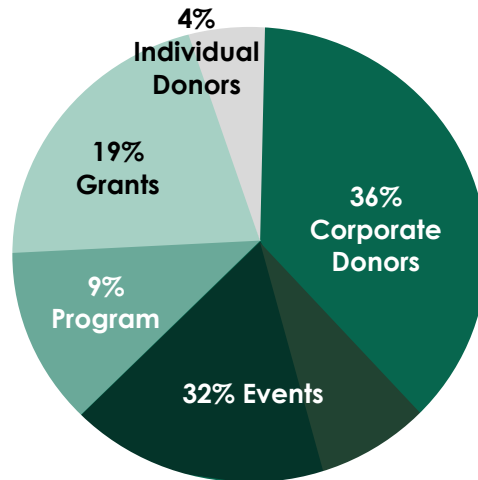
