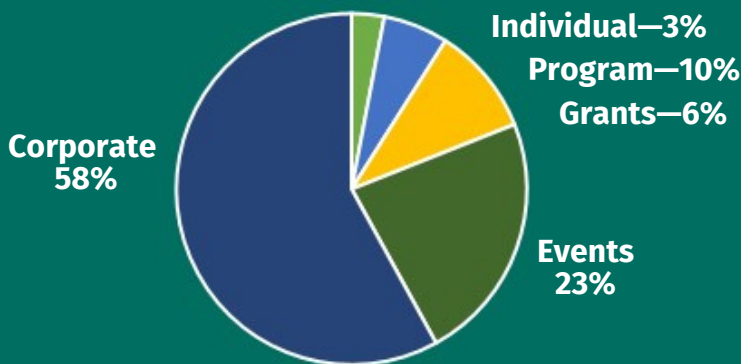

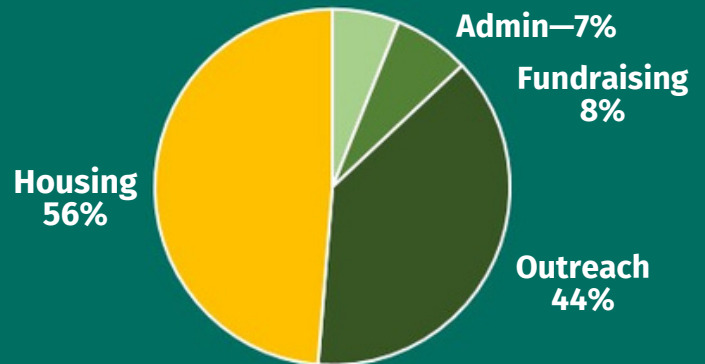

The Need

5,500 people experience homelessness in metro Atlanta on any given night.

- Experiencing chronic homelessness: 11.7%
- Youth: 5.9%
- Families: 15.5%
- Veterans: 10.8%
- Women: 25.8%

In 2022, we expanded our efforts to create permanent, affordable housing units by leveraging our position as a bridge between homebuilders, nonprofits, and the community.

HomeAid partnered with Leadership Atlanta, HouseATL, and Kennesaw State University's Construction Management Program to learn more and create solutions to the problem of affordable housing in metro Atlanta.



HomeAid CareKits
